Zora Walsh Oct. 2, 1941 -March 27, 2025 Zora: A Beacon of Light and Friendship by Suzanne Courser

I met Zora in the fall of 2001, just six months after surviving breast cancer. It was at the Into the Light Cancer Walk at Island Park where our paths first crossed. From the moment I was introduced to her, Zora made me feel incredibly welcome, as if I had walked into a gathering of old friends rather than strangers united by the shared experience of cancer. There were those still fighting, those who had survived, and those cherishing the memories of loved ones lost. Zora, with her caring, kind, and helpful nature, brought us all together.

Over the years, Zora and I became the dearest of friends. We shared countless phone calls, enjoyed lunches, and, most significantly, worked side-by-side on the Into the Light walk. One year, it was just the two of us handling all the planning. I remember feeling overwhelmed, but Zora, with unwavering faith, assured me that God would be with us. And she was right - that year turned out to be one of our most successful walks, all thanks to Zora's guidance, knowledge, and incredible patience.

Eventually, I took on the role of chairperson for the Into the Light walk, but Zora never left my side. She continued to guide and support me for many years, a true mentor in every sense of the word. Even when she became ill and could no longer actively participate in the walk, she remained my rock. She knew she had trained me well, and her encouragement and praise kept me going, especially when I felt like giving up.

Last September 6, 2024, we had the honor of celebrating Zora at our walk. Little did we know, it would be the last walk she would ever attend. On March 27, 2025, Zora "went into the light," following her Savior to the gates of eternal life.

Though she is no longer physically with us, the light she shared with me will glow forever. I miss you, Zora. This "little light of yours" will continue to shine brightly at each and every one of our cancer walks, a testament to your enduring spirit and the profound impact you had on so many live.





Betty Campbell March 2, 1940 - Jan. 11, 2025
